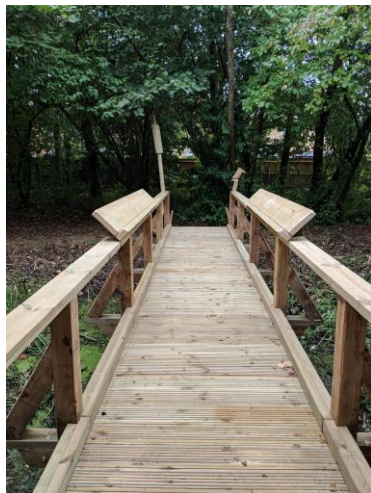
Are your contact details up to date?
