The school work with Living Streets and My Journey are working towards achieving a gold star award with Mode Shift stars.

Mode shift stars is the national schools awards scheme that has been established to recognise schools that have demonstrated excellence in supporting cycling, walking and other forms of sustainable travel. The scheme encourages schools across the country to join in a major effort to increase levels of sustainable and active travel in order to improve the health and well-being of children and young people.

Nursling are delighted to have completed the **Bronze level** and are awaiting the bronze award!!

The group meet on a regular basis supported by Mrs Goodman and two volunteer parents; Mrs Grierson and Mrs Hill.

The JRSO team promote travel themes each month and update the JRSO information board located on the playground.
