

# Young People's Outreach Support Services

## Support we provide

Our Young People's Outreach Support Services in the South provide support for young people aged 0-19 with special educational needs and learning disabilities. Our services are provided on a one-to-one basis and are provided in the home or at selected locations in the local community.

We support young people in having fun and developing their own abilities, providing outcome focused short breaks that support their development of independence and other life skills. The welfare of the young people we support is of paramount importance and we ensure that they are supported in a safe environment and ensure their health needs are fully met.

Prior to outreach support commencing we will visit the young person at home. During these home visits we learn as much as possible about the young person's needs and interests.

Once we have the information we need an individual care plan is created for the young person, which is in turn used by support workers to ensure that the support provided is tailored to the individual's needs and aspirations.

Regular contact between our outreach office and the young person's family ensures that each care plan is maintained and regularly reviewed.

We also support young people with their personal care in their home as well as pursuing social, recreational, sporting, educational and vocational interests in the community.
