


Rowan Class Newsletter

Literacy

We are studying the Science Fiction book *George's Secret Key to the Universe* by Stephen Hawkins. We will write recounts, explanation texts and narratives. I looking forward to reading some very imaginative pieces of writing.

PE and Games is on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Please remember to bring their house coloured kits. This half term we will be learning space dances and playing games.



ICT

We will be developing our coding skills with Scratch and further computing with Code.org.

Mathematics

In Maths we will be learning

- place value up to 1,000,000
- Formal addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division
- Securing our tables (up to 12x12) and division facts.

Science

In Science, we will be studying the Earth in Space. We learn the order of the planets and Phases of the Moon. We will find out about real life aboard the International Space Station. We will also begin our year-long study on weather for here and around the world.

In **R.E.** we will be learning about creation and how we can look after it.

Art

Our artist this half term is Peter Thorpe. We will study how he designs his paintings; identify the concepts and how he combines form and colour to produce his space paintings using oil pastels.



In **Geography**, we will learning about the Space Race Countries. We will be looking at the environmental factors and the physical and human features of the USA and Russia. In **History**, we will be learning about the Space Race, who finally landed on the moon and we will be learning about the 'Hidden Figures' behind the launch of Apollo 11.
